

Call for Rainbow Horizons Project Participants



LGBTI people are invited to participate in an important project to create greater support across generations in relation to end-of-life planning, care and dying.

Are you a member of the South Australian Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Intersex (LGBTI) community and interested in end-of-life planning, care and dying? If so, you may be interested in participating in our project.

What is this project about?

COTA SA, through our Rainbow Hub, is delivering the **Rainbow Horizons Project**, in partnership with Office for Ageing Well, to:

- facilitate conversations between LGBTI community members about end-of-life care, planning and dying, both between LGBTI elders, and between elders and younger members of the LGBTI community
- design and trial an intergenerational LGBTI 'compassionate community' model that supports end-of-life care, planning and dying
- engage with relevant service providers who might support trial LGBTI 'compassionate community' members (such as funeral businesses, aged care providers and palliative care services).

What does participation involve?

From April 2022 you will have the opportunity to be involved in a small focus or discussion group with other LGBTI people to discuss your considerations and experience of end-of-life planning, care and dying.

Focus groups will be held across South Australia in: Metropolitan Adelaide, Burra, Mt Gambier and Victor Harbor. Our facilitators are keen to talk to a range of people including those who have given this topic a lot of thought, and those who have not considered it at all.

Why get involved?

The Project aims to create greater mutual support across generations in relation to end-of-life planning, care and dying. By participating you will help shape a compassionate community model and assist businesses to better understand and respond to the needs of LGBTI people.
